

• First **select the project** that you want to export from the Package Explorer (left-hand side)



• Check the box next to the one project that you want



Click Browse... to select a location (e.g., Desktop) and

a filename for your archive

The archive file should have the extension .zip

Then click on Finish to create the file.



Checking the Archived project before submission

- Find the .zip file in your file system.
- Decompress the archive (usually by double clicking on it).
 - Note: Windows users may need to use the "Extract all" button http://windows.microsoft.com/en-us/windows-8/zip-unzip-files
- Check to make sure that the src directory contains all of the .java files that you want to submit.

What to submit for an assignment

- Submit the .zip file
- If you are using D2L make sure that the file is completely submitted before logging out.
 - Note that this often requires two different confirmation screens!
